1. Winterization of units unoccupied during winter months

Co-owner maintained decks needing attention – Defer (until next spring?) deciding what to do about co-owners who have been notified but neglect to act.

3. New business

Porch hand rails – When River Pines was built, code required a single hand rail for any stairs with 3 or more steps; the current code is to require a handrail if there are 4 or more steps. Our policy is to provide one handrail whenever requested. Bob reports that there are currently 93 porches without a handrail.

Driving on new asphalt – The committee discussed actions to take regarding the several instances of co-owners driving too soon on the fresh asphalt last month (in spite of admonitions and barriers); the issue was deferred to the next Board meeting.
